3,700 attend Sun city grand opening

More than 3,700 people from several states attended the grand opening of Del Webb Sun City Mesquite last weekend.

People came from Wyoming, Colorado, California, Oregon, Washington, Kansas and beyond, said Sasha Jackowich from Pulte Homes.

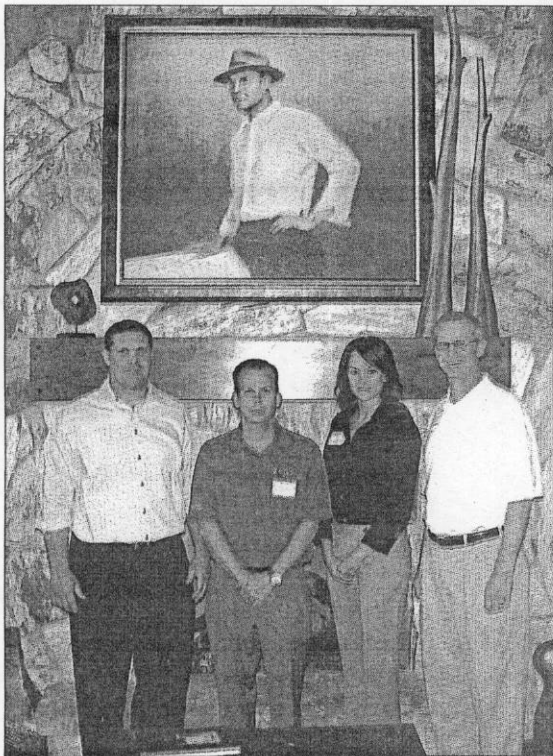
During the grand opening 20 contracts were signed. With more than 30 houses

under construction, the first Sun City residents should be moving in mid to late July.

Also under construction is the recreation center which is expected to open in November.

Sun City's signature golf course, Conestoga, is set to open in 2009.
